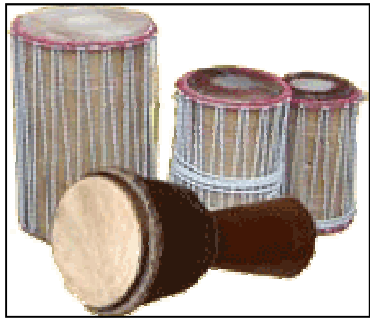


AFRICAN DRUMMING WORKSHOP
