Following a tremendously successful visit to CANADA in 2008, the Modern Languages Faculty would like to propose a return visit during the Easter break 2011; with a 10-day tour of Quebec and Ontario.

We should like offer pupils the opportunity to visit the spectacular scenery of Eastern Canada, experience a French-speaking culture other than that of France and to discover some of Canada's most interesting and diverse cities.

We do not envisage that this tour will be repeated within 4 years and therefore this trip will be open to all pupils currently in Years 7 - 9.

This will be an all-inclusive tour and will comprise the following:-

- \* Coach transfer to / from UK airport
- \* Return flight to Montreal
- \* Comprehensive medical insurance
- \* Visits to Montreal, Ottawa, Quebec, Toronto and Niagara Falls.
- \* School visit in Quebec (subject to availability)
- \* 9 nights accommodation in 3-4\* hotels
- \* Breakfast and evening meals
- \* Use of coach in Canada for excursions
- \* Entry fees on excursions as per itinerary
- \* Services of guides and Tour director throughout our stay

We appreciate that this tour will involve a considerable financial undertaking for a family and for this reason we are allowing 13 months preparation time.
